

1 Q. How is the monthly average cost of fuel for the energy source in the current
2 month determined? What does the 10% following the administrative and
3 variable operating and maintenance charge refer to and what is its
4 justification (Schedule A, page 3 of 27)?

6 A. The monthly average cost of fuel is determined by dividing the total cost of
7 fuel used by that source type (ie diesel, gas turbine, Holyrood) in the current
8 month by the volume of fuel used by the source type in the current month.
