Q. 1 How is the monthly average cost of fuel for the energy source in the current month determined? What does the 10% following the administrative and 2 3 variable operating and maintenance charge refer to and what is its 4 justification (Schedule A, page 3 of 27)? 5 6 A. The monthly average cost of fuel is determined by dividing the total cost of 7 fuel used by that source type (ie diesel, gas turbine, Holyrood) in the current month by the volume of fuel used by the source type in the current month. 8 9 10 The 10% charge is explained in the answer to IC-44.
