Q. 1 (p.12, lines 1-13) Describe the criteria Hydro have established for 2 determining the commercial feasibility of wind generation. Has Hydro 3 investigated or issued RFPs for other alternate technologies? 4 5 6 A. Hydro has not established criteria for determining the commercial feasibility 7 of wind generation. One of the primary objectives of the Phase I, feasibility 8 study, of Hydro's RFP for a Wind Demonstration Project, is to identify how 9 various technical, operating and cost factors will be taken into consideration 10 when evaluating the economic feasibility of a potential wind generation site. 11 12 Hydro has been monitoring the progress of other alternate technologies such 13 as fuel cells, microturbines and photovoltaic solar panels. 14 15 Hydro has not issued RFPs for other alternate technologies.
