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1	Q.	That same D.B.R.S. Report at page 6 provides a breakdown of electricity
2		sold to utilities (mainly Newfoundland Light & Power). That breakdown shows
3		declining sales to utilities from 1997 to 1999. Please provide reasons for this
4		decline.

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A. The decline in Hydro's sales to Newfoundland Power from 1997 to 1999 can be primarily attributed to warmer weather conditions during 1998, and still warmer conditions in 1999, relative to 1997. This reduced the number of heating degree days in those years, and in a similar fashion, reduced the volume of sales for weather sensitive end-use loads such as space heating.
