Q. Explain how Hydro delivers power to Newfoundland Power at Pasadena and
Marble Mountain and what transmission facilities are used for that purpose.

A. Hydro does not have equipment connected to Newfoundland Power's Pasadena and Marble Mountain stations except for metering equipment. Corner Brook Pulp and Paper's 66 kV transmission line, L1, connects to both of these stations and they provide the power and energy to Newfoundland Power. Hydro delivers power and energy to Corner Brook Pulp and Paper at either or both of Hydro's Massey Drive Terminal Station and Corner Brook Pulp and Paper's Deer Lake Generating Station. Hydro provides a credit to Corner Brook Pulp and Paper through the metering arrangement for all

power and energy provided to Pasadena and Marble Mountain.
