Q. With reference to Budgell's evidence page 20, lines 16 – 20, what is the
rationale for changing the plant assignment of Doyles – Port-aux-Basques
line & terminal station to common?

A. The plant assignment of the Doyles – Port-aux-Basques lines, TL214 and TL215, and the Doyles Terminal Station was changed to common to make the assignment consistent with the Board's recommendation on assignment on the Great Northern Peninsula as outlined on page 33 of its report entitled "Report of the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities to the Honourable Minister of Mines and Energy, Government of Newfoundland and Labrador on a Referral by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council Concerning Rural Electrical Service", dated July 29, 1996.
