1 Q. How is billing demand to be determined for non-firm energy (Schedule C 2 indicates the maximum Interruptible Demand for any month)? 3 4 5 A. There are two categories of non-firm power and energy, Interruptible Power 6 and Energy and Generation Outage Power and Energy. 7 8 The Interruptible Demand billing is based on the Maximum Interruptible 9 Demand measured in the month as described in the Interpretation and 10 Interruptible Demand articles to the contracts in Schedule C. 11 12 The Generation Outage Demand billing is based on the Maximum 13 Generation Outage Demand measured in the month and pro-rated by the 14 number of days in the month the customer took the Generation Outage 15 Power and Energy. The Generation Outage Demand billing is described in 16 the Generation Outage Power article in the contracts in Schedule C. Please 17 refer to Article 5, Clause 5.01 (d) for Abitibi Consolidated Inc.
