Explain why the terminal station(s) is classified as production demand 10 and/or production and transmission energy. 11 12 13 The terminal station is Paradise River. A. a. 14 15 b. This asset was coded as Production Support, which is classified to 16 demand and energy based on total production demand and energy 17 ratios (48%/52%), derived from line 12. This asset should have been 18 coded more specifically to hydraulic production and classified to 19 demand and energy based on the hydraulic classification ratios 20 (41%/59%). This change will be incorporated in a revised filing.
