1 Q. Further to NP-11 and NP-12, does Hydro have formal written policies to 2 guide the allocation of costs to subsidiaries and the allocation of costs 3 between regulated and non-regulated operations? If so, please provide a 4 copy. If not, why not?. 5 6 Α. Hydro presently has three subsidiaries of which two are inactive and in the 7 case of CF(L)Co., the procedure for allocation of costs is outlined in the 8 response to NP-11(b). 9 10 At the present time, non-regulated operations e.g., sales of recall power and 11 Labrador Hydro project, are not complex enough to warrant formal written 12 policies. Hydro has established practices whereby employees use timesheet 13 reporting to allocate costs and charges are developed to cover occupancy 14 and overhead costs. Wherever possible, suppliers' costs are charged directly 15 to the non-regulated operation.
