Further to NP-23, justify the increase of 36 vehicles in Hydro's fleet (398 in 2 2001 vs. 362 in 1999), in light of the reduction of 46 permanent employees 3 referred to in NP-6 (855 employees in 2001 vs. 901 employees in 1999). 4 5 Α. Referring to NP-23, pages 9 and 11, the total vehicles are actually 267 for 6 1999 (not 362) and 285 for 2001 (not 398) for a difference of 18. The 5000 7 and 6000 series are attachments for vehicles in the 3000 and 4000 series. 8 The increase in vehicles from 1999 to 2001 is as follows: 9 10 Seventeen vehicles are assigned to various projects and will either be 11 disposed of or replace older vehicles at the end of the projects. 12 13 One additional vehicle was assigned to the IS&T eastern group. 14 15 The realignment of staff resulted in the displacement of four vehicles; three 16 which will be disposed of in 2002, and the fourth reassigned to Mary's 17 Harbour resulting from a change in operations due to the availability of the 18 new Labrador Highway.
