1 Q. In response to NP-20, Hydro points out that a new multi-skilled classification "Diesel System Representative" (DSR) was created. In addition to the 2 3 traditional duties, this classification can also perform meter reading. The 4 number of meter readers/collectors on the 1992 organization chart is 13 5 compared to 18 on the 2001 chart. Why has this number increased? What impact will the implementation of the DSR positions have on the number of 6 7 meter readers/collectors? 8 9 10 Α. The number of meter readers/collectors has not changed since 1992. The 11 reason for the difference in the 1992 and 2001 organizational charts is a 12 change in the reporting structure. Prior to a 1998 re-structuring of Customer 13 Services five (5) meter readers who worked directly from a Regional Office 14 also reported to that office. These five meter readers are therefore listed on 15 the 1992 organization charts under the Operations Division and not the 16 Finance Division, as are the other 13. 17

All isolated diesel systems where DSR positions will be implemented, with the exception of the Labrador Straits and Ramea, have meter reading services provided by part-time meter readers. All these part-time positions

will be eliminated with the implementation of the DSR position.
