1	Q.	(a)	Has NLH completed studies on the elasticity of demand for energy
2			with respect to price for various consumers in the province?
3			
4		(b)	Please provide the most recent estimates and associated studies.
5

7	A.	(a)	While Hydro annually updates its own econometric equations used for
8			preparing long term load forecasts, it does not undertake elasticity
9			studies per se.
10			
11		(b)	The most recent price elasticity estimates fall in the range of -0.15 to
12			-0.33. For example, if the price elasticity is -0.15 then a 1% increase
13			in price will result in a 0.15% decrease in electricity consumption.
