12	A.	(a)	Yes, these staff members are assigned only to work related to diesel
13			systems.
14			
15		(b)	Diesel System Representatives generally live in the communities they
16			service, but on occasion they may perform work in other diesel
17			systems. Examples include filling in for another Diesel System
18			Representative on sick leave, filling in for vacancies while new
19			candidates are being recruited, or during emergency situations.
