Hydro's statistics are higher compared to those of Newfoundland Power for several reasons. Most of Hydro's customers are in rural areas supplied by radial lines whereas Newfoundland Power's customers are largely concentrated in urban centers served by multiple lines. This allows
Newfoundland Power to quickly isolate lines and other equipment problems while maintaining continuity of service to their customers. It also enables
Newfoundland Power to perform planned maintenance on lines and feeders

without impacting customers.
