Q. In NLH's service territory, has there been any sales growth in recent years
and, if so, name the communities where such growth has occurred.

A. With the exception of the Island isolated communities, Hydro has generally seen widespread, modest growth in total electricity sales across its service territory in the past five years. As the Hydro service territory is diverse, there are regional variations. For example, the communities associated with the Labrador isolated systems continue to record strong growth while the Island's isolated communities, as a group, tend to be weak or declining. Both the Island and Labrador interconnected service areas have shown an overall growth in total sales.
