

1 Q. In the August 12, 2003 covering letter from NLH to the PUB, it is noted that  
2 the revised Application incorporates the decision of the Board in Order No.  
3 P.U. 19 (2003) that approved revised rates for NP customers. NP's revised  
4 rates flow through to a number of NLH's rural customers. In this regard,  
5 please provide a table comparing each component of NP customer rates to  
6 each component of all NLH customer rates that are linked to the NP rates,  
7 with notes explaining the derivation in each case.

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9 A. Hydro automatically adjusts the rates charged to Island Interconnected,  
10 L'Anse au Loup, and Isolated rural customers for the first 700 kWh per month  
11 of consumption, other than Government departments and agencies, so that  
12 the rates are the same as the rates charged by NP to its customers. Hydro  
13 automatically changes the rates charged for consumption over 700 kWh per  
14 month to Isolated Rural customers, other than Government departments and  
15 agencies, by the average rate of change granted to NP.

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17 There are no differences between Hydro's and NP's rates schedules except  
18 for some street and area lighting components not offered by Hydro. Note  
19 that the rates contained in P.U. 19 (2003) exclude Municipal Tax and Rate  
20 Stabilization Adjustments.

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22 The following is a summary of existing rates (including Municipal Tax and  
23 Rate Stabilization Adjustments) effective August 1, 2003
