

1 Q. In his pre-filed testimony (p.3) Mr. Banfield referred to the report by Stone &
2 Webster Management Consultants and its recommendation that an energy
3 and demand rate structure, rather than the current energy-only charge, be
4 adopted once a number of issues are resolved. Mr. Banfield indicated that in
5 light of that report, NLH also recommends, subject to resolution of those
6 issues, that such a rate be implemented instead of the energy-only charge.
