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 Actual utility sales being higher or lower than expected based on weather variation above or below temperature normals;

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 Actual Hydro sales being higher or lower than expected based on variation in its customers' own hydroelectric production being higher or lower than normal; and

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 Actual Hydro sales to industrials being temporarily lower due to operational downtime at industrial facilities.
