1Q.Further to the response to NLH-57 NP, who would benefit from the reduction in2payments to Hydro of approximately \$504,000, shareholders or customers?

3
4 A. If the reduction in payments were forecast to occur in a test year used to set
5 Newfoundland Power's retail rates, customers would receive the benefit.

If the reduction was not built into a forecast test year and did not cause Newfoundland
Power to exceed the top of its allowed range of rate return on rate base, the after-tax
reduction in expense accrues to shareholders. If the reduction was not built into a test
year and the reduced expense resulted in Newfoundland Power exceeding the top of the
allowed range of rate of return on rate base, the excess would accrue to customers.
