NLH-253 LC With respect to commentary on Page 4 and 5, what difference is there between an “integrated” and an “interconnected” system?

Response

“Interconnected” refers to the physical connection of systems so that power can flow between them. “Integrated” refers to combined operation. For example, Hydro is interconnected with Hydro-Québec, but their operations are not integrated. In the current context, the terms are essentially synonymous.
