1 Q. If there are customers' whose usage peak in seasons other than winter,
2 won't there be some demand related costs on the distribution system, in
3 particular, the cost of components closest to the customer such as a pole
4 mounted transformer, partially driven by peaks that occur during periods
5 other than winter?

While there are some distribution costs partially driven by peaks that occur
 during periods other than winter, demand costs are allocated to Hydro's
 customers using a single, coincident, winter peak.
