1	Q.	PUB-149 NLH states "the illustrative rate is generation-independent". Does
2		the inverted rate block in the sample demand energy rate provide an
3		incentive to Newfoundland Power to increase storage levels at it's hydro
4		plants during Autumn to generate more power during the winter months and
5		maximize savings in purchased power costs?
6		
7		
8	A.	No, the load variation component of the RSP, as is currently the case, will
9		stabilize annual energy sales to NP's test year forecast.
10		
11		With regard to demand, the illustrative rate is generation-independent under
12		the recommended Option A, as is currently the case.
