1	Q.	Further to NP-71 NLH: Of those utilities that use energy estimates in rate
2		setting, does Hydro know the basis on which these estimates are
3		determined?
4		
5		
6	A.	Six of the ten utility respondents replied that they use energy estimates to set
7		rates. In each case, the basis for the estimates was modeling, using input
8		streamflow sequences of varying lengths, as noted below:
9		
10		<ul> <li>One utility used streamflow information from 1973 to present. The</li> </ul>
11		respondent noted that 1973 represented the earliest data available;
12		
13		<ul> <li>One utility used a streamflow record of 58 years;</li> </ul>
14		
15		<ul> <li>One utility used a streamflow record of 70 years;</li> </ul>
16		
17		<ul> <li>One utility used a streamflow record of 86 years; and</li> </ul>
18		
19		<ul> <li>Two utilities used streamflow records of 60 years.</li> </ul>
20		
21		Rates for the other utilities are set by the market or a market operator.
