7	A.	The fringe benefit calculation is based on an estimate of company
8		contributions for the Provincial Pension Plan, the Canada Pension Plan,
9		Employment Insurance and Worker's Compensation Benefits. Normally, the
10		estimate for budgeting purposes is based on the previous year's actuals
11		which has been approximately 13% of the salary expenses for the past few
12		years. Fringe benefits for 2003 and 2004 are estimated to increase by
13		approximately 1% due to increases in both the Provincial Pension Plan and
14		Canada Pension Plan contributions.
