^{(1) 2001} to 2002 increase of approximately \$200,000 is mainly due to additional pump repair parts, additional Non Destructive Testing (NDT) requirements, and an increase in environmental equipment maintenance.

^{(2) 2002} to 2003 increase of approximately \$360,000 is mainly due to replacement of exhausted condensate polisher resins, inspection and repair of No.3 main fuel oil tank.

^{(3) 2003} to 2004 increase of approximately \$550,000 is mainly due to the planned replacement of the caustic/phosphate injection skid, replacement of landfill liner, upgrade of the plant elevator hoist controls, and replacement, of a portion of the Turbine Hall Roof.
