Q. Please describe in detail the type of service provided to a customer on the
Industrial Wheeling rate schedule from both an operational perspective as
well as in terms of rights and obligations.

A. A customer on the Industrial Wheeling rate can use Hydro's transmission network to transfer energy from one of its generating sites to one of its load centres. It is subject to the terms and conditions as outlined in the Wheeling article of their contracts which were approved in Order No. PU-7 (2002-2003). Currently ACCC uses this to transfer electricity generated at their Buchans hydro-electric station to either of their mills and to transfer to the Stephenville mill electricity generated at Grand Falls and Bishops Falls, exclusive of the Exploits River Hydro Partnerships' energy, that is surplus to the Grand Falls mill's requirement.
