

1    Q.    In light of the Orders in Council, does Hydro intend to modify the definition of  
2           Rate 2.2F to apply to customers with a peak demand greater than 30 kW?

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5    A.    Rate 2.2F is no longer relevant since Government has directed that  
6           interconnected rates continue to be charged to the fish plants in isolated  
7           systems. In 1980, Government directed that “Fish Plants with a load of 30  
8           kW or more in diesel areas ... be charged the interconnected rate”. Hydro  
9           has interpreted this as connected load and since all fish plants have a  
10          connected load of at least 30 kW then all would get the preferential rate.  
11          Hydro has also traditionally interpreted that this rate is only for the processing  
12          facility itself and not supporting facilities such as offices or ice making  
13          facilities.
