1	Q.	If the Board were to approve a demand-based rate as described on page 3 of
2		Mr. Banfield's evidence and in PUB 150 NLH, what administrative steps
3		would NLH need to undertake to immediately begin charging the new NP
4		rate? Upon receiving the Board's decision, how long would it take to
5		implement these steps?
6		
7		
8	Α.	The following administrative steps would need to be undertaken prior to
9		implementing a demand rate component for Newfoundland Power:
10		
11		 agreement on the method for determining the demand supplied by
12		Newfoundland Power generation;
13		 agreement on the method for determining demand for points where
14		electronic metering does not exist;
15		 agreement between Newfoundland Power and Hydro regarding a method
16		for weather normalization; and
17		 a review of the Rate Stabilization Plan to ensure that any revision to
18		energy charges is properly reflected.
19		
20		In addition, there should be a clear understanding by all parties of how the
21		implementation of a demand rate component would work if the rate were not
22		implemented at the beginning of the year.
23		
24		Subject to the agreement on the method of demand determination referred to
25		above, Hydro believes a two-month timeframe would be adequate to address
26		the above items.
