Q.	How does a "proactive maintenance approach" apply to the replacement of
	computer equipment? (JRH p. 11, line 9)
Α.	With the dependence on technology in today's operation environment any
	"breakdown" will affect productivity. However, the degree of that effect will
	vary depending on user's duties, the degree of utilization of the equipment
	and criticality of that application or system. Hydro employs computer
	technology widely, eg. PCs, servers, control equipment, energy management
	systems and so on. Based on common industry practice, discussions with
	consultants and specific vendor information, Hydro has adopted a proactive
	approach in many areas of its operation. Run to failure is not an acceptable
	alternative for continued productivity.
