## IN THE MATTER OF THE *PUBLIC UTILITIES ACT*, (THE "ACT");

## **AND**

IN THE MATTER OF AN APPLICATION BY NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR HYDRO ("HYDRO") FOR APPROVAL OF: (1) ITS 2004 CAPITAL BUDGET PURSUANT TO SECTION 41(1) OF THE ACT; (2) ITS 2004 CAPITAL PURCHASES, AND CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS IN EXCESS OF \$50,000 PURSUANT TO SECTION 41(3)(a) OF THE ACT; AND (3) ITS ESTIMATED CONTRIBUTIONS IN AID OF CONSTRUCTION FOR 2004 PURSUANT TO SECTION 41(5) OF THE ACT.

**WHEREAS** on March 28, 2003 Hydro filed with The Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities (the "*Board*") an Application, requesting that the Board make an Order:

- (i) Approving Hydro's 2004 Capital Budget, pursuant to Section 41(1) of the *Act*;
- (ii) Approving 2004 capital purchases and construction projects in excess of \$50,000.00, pursuant to Section 41(3) of the *Act*; and
- (iii) Approving the proposed estimated contributions in aid of construction for 2004 pursuant to Section 41(5) of the *Act*; and

**WHEREAS** on April 16, 2003 the Board published Notice of the Application and Hearing which was scheduled to be held on June 10, 2003; and

WHEREAS on May 2, 2003 Intervenor Submissions were filed on behalf of Newfoundland Power Inc., ("Newfoundland Power") as well as Abitibi Consolidated Inc. (Grand Falls), Abitibi Consolidated Inc. (Stephenville), Corner Brook Pulp & Paper Limited and on May 15, 2003 North Atlantic Refining Limited (the "Industrial Customers"); and

**WHEREAS** on May 15, 2003 the Board received a motion from the Industrial Customers to, among other things, postpone the hearing into the capital budget application; and

**WHEREAS** on May 30, 2003 the Board issued Order No. P.U. 16 (2003) postponing the start of the hearing of the capital budget application to June 25, 2003; and

**WHEREAS** on June 6, 2003 the Industrial Customers filed motion for a further delay in the start of the hearing; and

**WHEREAS** the other parties in the matter, Hydro and Newfoundland Power, have consented to a delay in the start of the hearing to the 7<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2003.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT

1. The public hearing of the capital budget application will begin at 9:00 A.M. on Monday, July 7, 2003, unless otherwise directed by the Board.
