1 Q. Re p. B-19, provide copies of any Orders of the Department of Environment 2 or any other authority having jurisdiction requiring that monitoring capability 3 be expanded as contemplated in this project. 4 5 6 A. Hydro has not received an order from the Department of Environment or any 7 other authority to expand the ambient air monitoring sites to include NOx and 8 fine particulate. 9 10 However, in a letter dated March 31, 1999, Mr. Derrick Maddocks, P. Eng., 11 Director, Pollution Prevention Division of the Department of Environment 12 stated the following when addressing our particulate monitoring program: 13 "...at this time, concerns nationally and provincially are more appropriately 14 focused on the health impacts of fine particulate. We would therefore 15 recommend that the program be configured to monitor fine particulate." 16 Refer to the response to IC-29 for this letter and further documentation.
