2006 General Rate Application -

Burgeo School and Library Preferential Rate

In late January of 2007 Hydro was contacted by Mr. Thomas Johnson, the Consumer Advocate appointed in this matter, as to the issue of the discontinuation of the preferential rate for the Burgeo School and Library. As you are aware, in Hydro's August 3, 2006 application, Hydro had specifically proposed that this rate class be closed on the basis that the school to which this rate class applied had closed and that the new school in Burgeo had a different owner. On a closer consideration of the facts, it was determined that the 2003 Order in Council affecting this customer class was issued shortly before the new school was to open and therefore that the intent was that this preferential rate be continued and that it be applicable to this new school.

Hydro indicated to the Board in its written submission dated February 9, 2007 that it was withdrawing its proposal to close this rate class and would propose to reinstate it and to rectify the matter. Hydro confirmed this position in its oral argument before the Board on February 13, 2007. Hydro therefore hereby proposes that this rate class be continued and has attached here the "rate sheet" for this customer. This rate has been calculated by escalating the previous rate in accordance with the manner prescribed by previous Orders in Council. This calculation is shown below:
