**IN THE MATTER OF** the *Electrical Power Control Act*, RSNL, 1994, c. E-5.1 (the “*EPCA*”) and the *Public Utilities Act* RSNL, 1990, c. P-47 (“the *Act*”) and their subordinate regulations;

**AND IN THE MATTER OF** an Application by Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro (“Hydro”) for approval of, under Section 70 of the *Act*, changes in the rates to be charged for the supply of power and energy to Newfoundland Power Inc., (Newfoundland Power”), Rural Customers and Industrial Customers; and under Section 71 of the *Act*, changes in the Rules and Regulations applicable to the supply of electricity to Rural Customers;

**AND IN THE MATTER OF** an Application by Hydro for approval of Rate Changes to Hydro’s Rural Island Interconnected Customers and Isolated Non-Government Rural Customers.

1   **WHEREAS** Hydro is a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the Province  
2   of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a public utility within the meaning of the *Act*, and is also  
3   subject to the provisions of the *EPCA, 1994*; and  
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5   **WHEREAS** on August 3, 2006 Hydro filed its General Rate Application with the Board seeking  
6   approval of, among other things, a new schedule of rates, tolls and charges, and also seeking  
7   approval of changes to certain of its Rules and Regulations of service; and  
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9   **WHEREAS** on December 6, 2006 Hydro filed a revised General Rate Application (“Revised  
10   Application”) seeking approval of final rates, or in the alternative interim rates, for consumption  
11   on or after January 1, 2007, and also seeking approval of changes to certain of its Rules and  
12   Regulations of service; and  
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14   **WHEREAS** in Order No. P.U. 20 (2004) the Board approved Hydro’s revisions to the Rules and  
15   Regulations – Schedule C which includes Policies for Automatic Rate Changes (section 16); and  
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17   **WHEREAS** the above noted policy states that, as Newfoundland Power changes its rates, Hydro  
18   will automatically adjust its rates for the Island Interconnected System, the L’Anse au Loup  
19   System, and the Isolated systems; and  
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21   **WHEREAS** in Order Nos. P. U. 22 (2006) and P. U. 37 (2005) the Board approved revisions to  
22   the existing rates for Hydro’s Island Interconnected Customers, Isolated Rural Domestic  
23   Customers, Isolated General Service Customers, and for Isolated Rural Street and Area Lighting;

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26   **WHEREAS** in Order No. P.U. 41 (2006) the Board approved the 2007 rates proposed in  
27   Hydro’s Revised Application on an interim basis to be effective January 1, 2007; and  
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1   **WHEREAS** in Order No. P. U. 42 (2006) the Board approved, on an interim basis, the schedules  
2   of rates, tolls and charges proposed by Newfoundland Power to be effective on all energy  
3   consumed on and after January 1, 2007; and  
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5   **WHEREAS** the Government has directed by Order in Council that changes in rates charged to  
6   Non-Government Rural Isolated Domestic and General Service customers shall be equal to the  
7   change approved for the equivalent rate classes of Newfoundland Power customers on or after  
8   January 1, 2007; and  
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10   **WHEREAS** Hydro proposes rates for the sale of power and energy to its Island Interconnected  
11   customers (Rate Class 1.1, 2.1, 2.2, 2.3, 2.4 and 4.1), Isolated Rural Domestic customers (Rate  
12   Class 1.2D), Isolated General Service customers (Rate Classes 2.1D and 2.2D) and Isolated  
13   Rural street and area lighting (Rate Class 4.1D) to be implemented as of January 1, 2007, which  
14   are based on the 2007 interim rates approved for Newfoundland Power; and

15   **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the rates as proposed by Hydro should be approved as  
16   filed on an interim basis.  
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19   **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**  
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22   The Board hereby approves, on an interim basis, the schedule of rates attached as Schedule "A"  
23   to this Order, to be effective for consumption on and after January 1, 2007.

**ORDER NO. P. U. 43(2006)**

**NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR HYDRO**  
**RATE No. 1.1**  
**DOMESTIC - INTERIM**

**Availability:**

For Service to a Domestic Unit or to buildings or facilities which are on the same Serviced Premises as a Domestic Unit and used by the same Customer exclusively for domestic or household purposes, whether such buildings or facilities are included on the same meter as the Domestic Unit or metered separately.

**Rate:** (Includes Municipal Tax and Rate Stabilization Adjustments)

Basic Customer Charge: ..... \$15.59 per month

Energy Charge:

All kilowatt-hours ..... @ 8.935¢ per kWh

Minimum Monthly Charge ..... \$15.59

**Discount:**

A discount of 1.5% of the amount of the current month's bill, but not less than \$1.00, will be allowed if the bill is paid within 10 days after it is issued.

**General:**

Details regarding conditions of service are provided in the Rules and Regulations. **This rate does not include the Harmonized Sales tax (HST) which applies to electricity bills.**

**NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR HYDRO**  
**RATE No. 2.1**  
**GENERAL SERVICE 0 - 10 Kw - INTERIM**

**Availability<sup>1</sup>:**

For Service (excluding Domestic Service) where the maximum demand occurring in the 12 months ending with the current month is less than 10 kilowatts.

**Rate:** (Includes Municipal Tax and Rate Stabilization Adjustments)

Basic Customer Charge: ..... \$17.88 per month

Energy Charge:

All kilowatt-hours ..... @ 11.462¢ per kWh

Minimum Monthly Charge: Single Phase..... \$17.88

Three Phase..... \$35.76

**Discount:**

A discount of 1.5% of the amount of the current month's bill, but not less than \$1.00, will be allowed if the bill is paid within 10 days after it is issued.

**General:**

Details regarding conditions of service are provided in the Rules and Regulations. **This rate does not include the Harmonized Sales tax (HST) which applies to electricity bills.**

**NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR HYDRO**  
**RATE No. 2.2**  
**GENERAL SERVICE 10 - 100 kW (110 kVA) - INTERIM**

**Availability<sup>1</sup>:**

For Service (excluding Domestic Service) where the maximum demand occurring in the 12 months ending with the current month is 10 kilowatts or greater but less than 100 kilowatts (110 kilovolt-amperes).

**Rate:** (Including Municipal Tax and Rate Stabilization Adjustments)

Basic Customer Charge: .....\$20.60 per month

**Demand Charge:**

\$8.63 per kW of billing demand in the months of December, January, February and March and \$7.88 per kW in all other months. The billing demand shall be the maximum demand registered on the meter in the current month.

**Energy Charge:**

First 150 kilowatt-hours per kW of billing demand.....@ 9.108¢ per kWh

All excess kilowatt-hours.....@ 6.102¢ per kWh

**Maximum Monthly Charge:**

The Maximum Monthly Charge shall be 15.9 cents per kWh plus the Basic Customer Charge, but not less than Minimum Monthly Charge.

**Minimum Monthly Charge:**

Single Phase .....\$20.60 per month

Three Phase: .....\$35.76 per month

**Discount:**

A discount of 1.5% of the amount of the current month's bill, but not less than \$1.00, will be allowed if the bill is paid within 10 days after it is issued.

**General:**

Details regarding metering [in particular Regulation 7 (n)], transformation [in particular Regulation 9(k)], and other conditions of service are provided in the Rules and Regulations. **This rate does not include the Harmonized Sales tax (HST) which applies to electricity bills.**

**NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR HYDRO**  
**RATE No. 2.3**  
**GENERAL SERVICE 110 kVA (100 kW) - 1000 kVA - INTERIM**

**Availability<sup>1</sup>:**

For Service where the maximum demand occurring in the 12 months ending with the current month is 110 kilovolt-amperes (100 kilowatts) or greater but less than 1000 kilovolt-amperes.

**Rate:** (Including Municipal Tax and Rate Stabilization Adjustments)

Basic Customer Charge: .....\$92.73 per month

**Demand Charge:**

\$7.46 per kVA of billing demand in the months of December, January, February and March and \$6.71 per kVA in all other months. The billing demand shall be the maximum demand registered on the meter in the current month.

**Energy Charge:**

First 150 kilowatt-hours per kVA of billing demand,

up to a maximum of 30,000 kilowatt-hours..... @ 8.722¢ per kWh

All excess kilowatt-hours..... @ 5.974¢ per kWh

**Maximum Monthly Charge:**

The Maximum Monthly Charge shall be 15.9 cents per kWh plus the Basic Customer Charge.

**Discount:**

A discount of 1.5% of the amount of the current month's bill, up to a maximum of \$500.00, will be allowed if the bill is paid within 10 days after it is issued.

**General:**

Details regarding metering [in particular Regulation 7 (n)], transformation [in particular Regulation 9(k)], and other conditions of service are provided in the Rules and Regulations. **This rate does not include the Harmonized Sales tax (HST) which applies to electricity bills.**

**NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR HYDRO**  
**RATE No. 2.4**  
**GENERAL SERVICE 1000 kVA AND OVER - INTERIM**

**Availability<sup>1</sup>:**

For Service where the maximum demand occurring in the 12 month period ending with the current month is 1000 kilovolt-amperes or greater.

**Rate:** (Including Municipal Tax and Rate Stabilization Adjustments)

Basic Customer Charge: ..... \$185.46 per month

**Billing Demand Charge:**

\$7.05 per kVA of billing demand in the months of December, January, February and March and \$6.30 per kVA in all other months. The billing demand shall be the maximum demand registered on the meter in the current month.

**Energy Charge:**

First 100,000 kilowatt-hours ..... @ 7.334¢ per kWh

All excess kilowatt-hours ..... @ 5.866¢ per kWh

**Maximum Monthly Charge:**

The Maximum Monthly Charge shall be 15.9 cents per kWh plus the Basic Customer Charge.

**Discount:**

A discount of 1.5% of the amount of the current month's bill, up to a maximum of \$500.00, will be allowed if the bill is paid within 10 days after it is issued.

**General:**

Details regarding metering [in particular Regulation 7 (n)], transformation [in particular Regulation 9(k)], and other conditions of service are provided in the Rules and Regulations. **This rate does not include the Harmonized Sales tax (HST) which applies to electricity bills.**

All churches, schools, and community halls in the diesel service areas are also subject to this rate.

Basic Customer Charge: ..... \$15.59 per month

**Discount:**

A discount of 1.5% of the amount of the current month's bill, but not less than \$1.00 or more than \$500.00, will be allowed if the bill is paid within 10 days after it is issued.

**General:**

Three Phase ..... \$59.75

**Discount:**

A discount of 1.5% of the amount of the current month's bill, but not less than \$1.00 or more than \$500.00, will be allowed if the bill is paid within 10 days after it is issued.
