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3 In the Decision and Order of the Board for P.U. 14, point 63 (page 163) states “The  
4 Board encourages NLH to continue to raise consumer awareness and  
5 develop/implement programs aimed at energy efficiency and conservation. The  
6 Board will not direct NLH at this time respecting demand side management  
7 initiatives but will consider the manner and timing of a generic proceeding which  
8 will address demand side management options and impacts on the overall system”.  
9 Does the Board have any plans to initiate such a generic proceeding, particularly in  
10 light of the increased marginal cost of fuel on the electrical system?
