1	Q.	With regard to the Haynes/Henderson/Cater evidence (page 16, lines 11 to
2		15), what is the current status of plans to use natural gas as a fuel source
3		and a direct current in-feed from Labrador? How does this relate to Hydro's
4		current integrated resource plan and the Provincial Government's
5		development of a long-term energy plan?

7		
8	Α.	The generation of electricity from natural gas and a direct current
9		transmission infeed from Labrador are both potential long-term power supply
10		options for the Island portion of the Province. However, a supply of natural
11		gas or a new source of generation in Labrador is required before either of the
12		options can be considered a part of a firm generation expansion plan. It is
13		expected that the Provincial Government's long-term energy plan will
14		address strategies for the development and utilization of natural gas and
15		Labrador hydroelectric power.
