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6 A. Hydro supports the findings and recommendations of the Stone & Webster
7 study related to the Cost of Service treatment of Newfoundland Power's
8 generation credit, and will incorporate the Board's decision in this manner in
9 its final Cost of Service study.
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11 With regard to the study's findings and recommendations related to
12 operational considerations, Hydro has held discussions with Newfoundland
13 Power in the past and will continue these discussions to ensure least cost
14 generation supply and maximum generation availability during the winter
15 periods.
