1	Q.	Does Hydro believe it is reasonable to have a limit on the RSP Hydraulic
2		Production Variation Balance upon which it should be required to propose
3		adjustments to customer rates to either refund or recover the outstanding
4		balance? If not, why not?
5		
6		
7	A.	Hydro does not believe that a predetermined dollar amount should be
8		imposed as a limit on the RSP Hydraulic Production Variation Balance, which
9		would trigger the refund or recovery of the outstanding balance.
10		
11		Hydro is averse to a limit on the RSP Hydraulic Production Variation Balance
12		for the following reasons:
13		
14		 In general, the recovery of large balances over a discrete period could
15		cause wide fluctuations in customer rates.
16		
17		 Full refund or recovery of the hydraulic production variation balance at
18		any one point in time would not accommodate the natural tendency of the
19		hydraulic production variation provision to tend toward zero over time.
20		
21		Additional comments concerning the hydraulic variation mechanism of the
22		RSP are found on pp. 5-8 of Hydro's report, Review of the Operation of the
23		Rate Stabilization Plan, filed in this proceeding in response to PUB 1 NLH.
