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Q. Given the age and condition of the gas turbine plants, the failure to start rates, unavailability of technical support, lack of replacement parts, hording of spare parts by other operators of similar plants, obsolescence of the engine and relatively few similar engines in service, is it necessary to undertake a condition assessment of the gas turbine units?

A. This project will identify all options for these two sites, including an assessment of how much longer it is feasible to continue to operate these units at a reasonable level of reliability. This will permit Hydro to continue operating the existing equipment as long as possible before making a large capital investment in replacement generating capacity. This will allow least cost generation expansion to meet planning criteria and provide reliable service to customers.
