It is not generally possible to draw a direct link between particular capital investments 10 and a specific reduction in the Company's workforce. Newfoundland Power's workforce levels are managed on a corporate basis. Appropriate adjustments are made as service 11 12 requirements evolve and as productivity improvements permit. 13 14 Improvements in productivity result from organizational restructuring, business process 15 improvements and the introduction of technology that allow for the more productive 16 allocation and utilization of Company resources. Productivity improvements enabled by 17 these measures can result in the same number of employees being able to accomplish 18 more, or in fewer employees being required to complete specific tasks. Where fewer employees are required to complete a specific task, an employee or employees may be 19 20 reassigned to other duties.

The quantification of achievable workforce reductions most often follows the implementation of productivity measures. Actual reductions are assessed on a corporate basis, as opposed to a project basis, in light of their possible impact on service levels.

Since 1992, the Company's workforce has decreased by approximately 33 per cent. The Company's investment in information technology has contributed to this workforce reduction.

The estimated cost of labour associated with this project is \$126,000. Non-labour costs are estimated at \$125,000.

36 37 The project requirements will be communicated to suppliers who are identified as having the capability to supply those requirements, with a view to obtaining bids pursuant to a formal tender call or proposals pursuant to a request for proposals process. If competing suppliers cannot be identified, materials and services will be negotiated with sole source suppliers to ensure they are obtained at the lowest available price.
