

- Graph 1 provides a summary of the capital budget per customer for the years 1983 to the A. proposed capital budget for 2003. The corresponding data can be found in Table 1.


From 2001 through 2003, Newfoundland Power's capital expenditures increased as a result of the purchase of joint use support structures from Aliant Telecom Inc. ("Aliant"). This extraordinary transaction was approved by the Board in Order No. P.U. 17 (2001-2002).

Graph 1 provides the capital expenditures per customer on two bases: (1) including the impact of the extraordinary additional capital expenditures related to the purchase of joint use support structures from Aliant, and (2) excluding the impact of extraordinary additional capital expenditures related to the purchase of joint use support structures from Aliant.

Excluding the impact of the extraordinary additional capital expenditures related to the purchase of joint use support structures from Aliant provides a more comparable year over year presentation of average rate base per customer. All costs, including capital costs, of the Aliant support structures are more than fully recovered from increased third party rentals.

It should be noted that the capital budget figures have not been adjusted for inflation.
