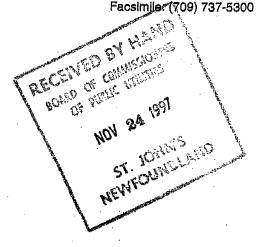

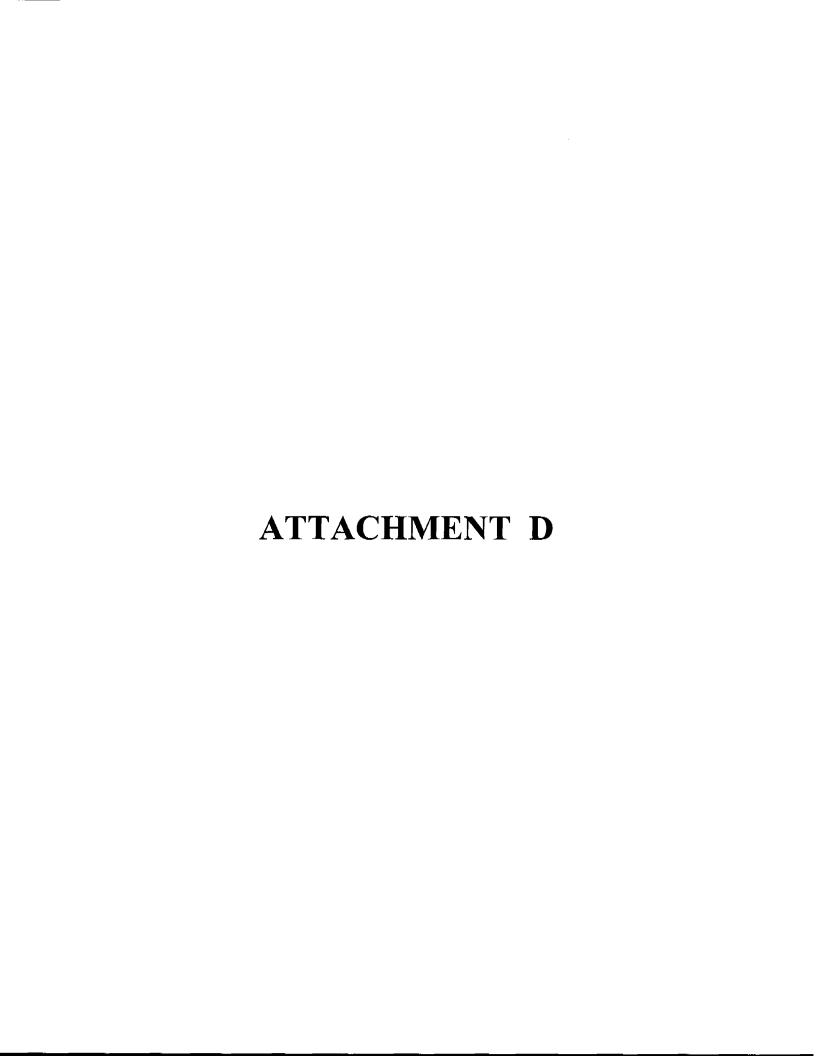

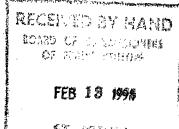

Enclosed are twelve (12) copies of the above-noted report. In connection therewith, the Company wishes to note the following:

- 1. Under the reported charges from Maritime Electric, there is an item for moving expenses which involves the costs incurred by Maritime Electric in connection with the disposition of the Prince Edward Island dwelling of Maritime's former Vice-President, Operations, Mr. Earl Ludlow, upon his move to Newfoundland Power.
- 2. Under the reported charges from Fortis Properties, a new heading, "Hotel/Banquet Facilities and Meals" has been added. This category has been added for improved clarity. In the comparative figures for 1997, this amount is included in the "Miscellaneous" category.
- 3. Also under the charges from Fortis Properties, certain routine expenditures on room rentals have not previously been included in inter-corporate transactions reporting. These transactions related to hotel bookings in the normal course of Company business which were billed directly to the Company. Upon reviewing the parameters of the inter-corporate reporting regime, the Company has determined that it is appropriate to report these transactions. All such charges paid directly to Fortis Properties will be included in future reporting.
- 4. Meanwhile, for the sake of completeness, we wish to note the following issue. When an employee travelling on Company business stays at a hotel, or charges a meal or other incidental expense, the employee will generally pay for the service using travel advance



funds, a company credit card or, in some instances, their personal credit card. Newfoundland Power then reimburses the employee directly or by payment of the employee's company credit card balance based on a properly-approved expense claim. Although such purchases of services are sometimes from related companies, such as Fortis Properties Corporation, they are not included on the inter-corporate transactions report to the Board. This is because the Company has treated such transactions as transactions between the Company and the employee, and not as Company transactions with the related company. Further, such transactions are at market prices, and are at the discretion of the employee, subject, of course, to reasonableness. In light of the Board's discussions of inter-corporate transaction reporting as contained in the 1991 and 1996 rate orders, the Company is of the view that such transactions are not the kind of non-arm's-length transactions that are open to the potential abuse the reporting regime is intended to guard against.
