Q. Ref: PUB-51 NP (1st Rev) and PUB-52 NP. Explain why the labour and engineering for the installation of transformers is included in the project costs for Extensions.

A. The labour and engineering costs for the installation of transformers is included in the project costs for Extensions and Reconstruction because there are no labour or engineering costs incurred upon the purchase of a transformer. When the transformer is installed as part of an extension of a distribution line, the associated labour and engineering costs are charged to the Extensions budget. When the transformer is installed as a replacement of an existing transformer, the associated labour and engineering costs are charged to the Reconstruction budget.
