Q. Ref: PUB-87 NP and PUB-88 NP. How many employees actively use (defined for the purposes of this reply as using the Application at least once a week) their version of MS Access?

A. Statistics on how many employees actively use their version of MS Access are not tracked.

There are currently 460 active Access databases installed on the Company's shared computing infrastructure. Some of these databases are used by individual employees for daily operations, while others are used by entire departments. Examples of these databases include:

- a Change Management database is used by all employees in the Information Services department to approve and schedule changes to the production infrastructure;
- a Contract Management database is used by the Materials Management group to track contracts;
- a Plant Records database is used by the Finance department to track fixed assets;
- a Content Management database is used by the Corporate Communications department to update the Company's Web Site; and,
- an Operator Log database is used by the Information Services department Computer Room Operators to record daily batch and backup activities.

Due to the widespread use of MS Access within the Company, it is operationally more effective to standardize Office Professional which includes MS Access licences.
