10 11 12 13 14		The "recommended guidelines" phrase refers to the statement in the Project Justification portion of B-55. It is as follows: "This project is required to maintain substation transformer loading, voltage regulation and / or customer loading density within recommended guidelines."
15 16 17 18 19 20		The question assumes that guidelines are 'currently' exceeded before projects are established. Such is not usually the case for Feeder Additions and Upgrades to Accommodate Growth. In most cases projects are established based on a forecast whereby if the proposed action is not taken, then the operation of the power system will not be within recommended guidelines.
21 22 23		The Chamberlains project will permit load transfer to prevent forecasted overloading of the Kelligrews Substation transformer.
24 25 26		The Glendale project will permit load transfer to prevent forecasted overloading of the Hardwoods Substation transformer.

The Springfield project will permit load transfer to prevent forecasted overloading of the

Bay Roberts Substation transformer.
