Real property required for the "electrical supply to customers" is generally considered to include facilities directly linked to the four main components of an electrical system; generation, substations, transmission and distribution. Such property would include the building housing generating plants or substation buildings. The Electrical Maintenance Facility and the Salt Pond Service Building, while an integral part of the overall operations of Newfoundland Power, are not considered to be directly related to either generation, substations, transmission or distribution assets.
