

Application Enhancements

Q. Explain why NP refers to the Process Improvements to be achieved through the upgrade of the Microsoft Great Plains Software in the “Application Enhancements” section of the budget (Appendix 1) when the cost for the upgrade is included under the separate project heading “Application Environment” (Appendix 2, p.1)

A. Executing a software upgrade does not imply that enhancements to the application have been (or will be) made. Software upgrades budgeted as part of the Application Environment project ensure an appropriate level of vendor support and a stable operating environment for the Company’s applications. Additional effort is often required to take advantage of potential improvements, such as business processes improvements, offered by the upgraded software, and this additional effort is budgeted as part of Application Enhancements.
