Of these, 34 customers or 26 percent still receive two or 16 more consolidated bills each month. 17 18 This project will address deficiencies which currently exist within the group billing 19 process. These deficiencies compromise the level of functionality and service to 20 customers that the group bill program was initially intended to provide, and generally serve as a disincentive to customers wishing to participate in the program. The 21 22 improvements to be made include providing customers with two or more accounts the 23 opportunity to receive only one consolidated bill each month regardless of how many 24 billing days there are between meter readings. 25 26 Overall, this project will implement improvements to make the group bill program more 27 efficient and beneficial to all customers with two or more accounts. Improving the group 28 bill program should result in increased customer participation in future.
