**NEWFOUNDLAND POWER INC.
2007 CAPITAL BUDGET APPLICATION**

TAKE NOTICE that on April 28, 2006 the Newfoundland and Labrador Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities (the “Board”) received an application (the “Application”) from Newfoundland Power Inc. (“Newfoundland Power”) requesting an Order of the Board pursuant to Sections 41 and 78 of the *Public Utilities Act* (the “Act”):

- 1) Approving its 2007 Capital Budget in the amount of \$62,166,000; and
- 2) Fixing and determining Newfoundland Power’s average rate base for 2005 in the amount of \$745,446,000.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that all customers of Newfoundland Power as well as customers of Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro whose rates are based on the rate schedules of Newfoundland Power may be affected by the outcome of the Application.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that anyone interested in participating in this Application must submit a Notice of Intention to participate to the Board **before 4:00 p.m., Friday, June 9, 2006**. The Notice can be in the form of a letter and should clearly state the intended participant’s interests, issues and concerns. Notices of Intention to participate must include contact information, including address and telephone number. Further communication as to the application process and timing will be made directly with participants.
