NOTICE OF APPLICATION

Facility Association Application for an Increase in Automobile Insurance Rates for Taxis

On March 31, 2022 Facility Association (Facility) filed an application with the Newfoundland and Labrador Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities seeking approval of increased automobile insurance rates on a territory basis for its Taxi class of business, to be effective 100 days post approval for new business and renewals.

Facility proposed a total overall average rate increase of +10.0% varying by coverage. Facility's proposed rate changes and alternative rate indications calculated by the Board's actuarial consultant, Oliver Wyman, are as follows:

Facility's proposed rates include a profit provision in its Taxi rates for the first time in this province. The inclusion of profit in Facility's rates is accepted in all the other jurisdictions where it operates and was accepted by the Board for private passenger rates in Order No. A.I. 48(2021). The profit provision proposed by Facility is 6.0% of premium which is consistent with the Board's benchmark profit provision for insurers. Oliver Wyman's alternate indications also include a profit provision of 6.0% of premium but reflect different assumptions with respect to loss trends.
