12 **WHEREAS** on September 5, 2017 Facility Association applied to the Board for approval of a
13 revised rating program for its Newfoundland and Labrador School Bus class of business in
14 accordance with Order No. A.I. 9(2017); and

17 **WHEREAS** on September 11, 2017 the Board’s actuarial consultants, Oliver Wyman Limited,
18 reported that the revised rating program complies with the parameters specified in Order No. A.I.
19 9(2017); and

22 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are not too high in the circumstances.

26 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

29 1. The revised rating program received September 5, 2017 from Facility Association for its
Newfoundland and Labrador School Bus class of business is approved to be effective no sooner
than March 1, 2018 for both new business and renewals.


31 2. Facility Association will pay all costs of the Board, including the cost of the actuarial review.
